Consultation on Reduction in Published Admission Number for entry from Autumn 2025, at Mercenfeld Primary School, Markfield

Bradgate Education Partnership ("the Trust") is the admissions authority for schools in the multi-academy trust and is required to comply with the <u>School Admissions Code</u> 2021 ("the Code").

The Trust is consulting on the proposed temporary reduction of the Published Admission Number (PAN) for entry into Reception year at Mercenfeld Primary School, Markfield – from **50** down to **30**.

The rationale for the proposed change is to support the school's financial sustainability, give greater stability to the school's planning and to enable the school and LA to appropriately manage pupil places. A fall in birth rates locally has resulted in a reduction in pupil numbers at Mercenfeld Primary School. In addition, Local Authority pupil forecast data indicates that pupil numbers coming into the school will remain low in the coming years.

The reduction in the admission number will only be temporary until such a time either births increase or the demand for school places increases. No other changes or amendments are proposed.

Proposal

Bradgate Education Partnership proposes that Mercenfeld Primary School has a temporary Published Admissions Number (PAN) of **30** for admissions from Autumn 2025, to remain in place until such time as birthrate increases or applications increase as a result of housing gains in the area.

The Trust is required to consult with local communities on the proposal, as required by the School Admissions Code. We are therefore beginning a six school week consultation period on **Friday 1**st **December 2023** which will run until **Friday 26**th **January 2024.**
