


In Year 4, we will continue learning how to form letters using a cursive style and join some of our letters.

Spelling


We will learn spelling pattrens and rules using The Spelling Shed scheme of work. Year 3 will also learn to read and write the LKS2 Statutory Spellings

Content to be taught and applied this year			
Word	The grammatical difference between plural and possessive —s 2 Standard English forms for verb inflections instead of local spoken forms (e.g. we were instead of we was)		
Sentence	Noun phrases expanded by the addition of : modifying adjectives, nouns, preposition phrases Fronted adverbials (e.g. Later that day,)		
Text	Use of paragraphs to organise ideas around a theme Appropriate choice of pronoun or noun within and across sentences to aid cohesion and avoid repetition		
Punctuation	Use of inverted commas and other punctuation to indicate direct speech Apostrophes to mark plural possession (e.g. the girls' names) Use of commas after fronted adverbials




